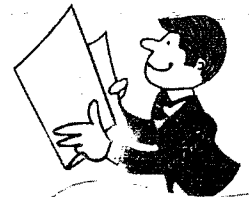
Leaf Pickup

Leaves are picked up the last Monday in Oct., every Monday in Nov. and the first Monday in Dec. Leaves MUST be curbside by 7:00 am on Monday morning when pickup begins. It takes several days to get through the Borough, be patient. Leaves MUST be free of twigs, garden waste, litter etc. Leaves MUST be at the curb, not in alleys, driveways or yards. Employees WILL NOT go onto private property.

If you hear a loud siren occasionally, and wonder what it is, rest easy. That is the "fire siren", a means of alerting the volunteers of an emergency in our area.



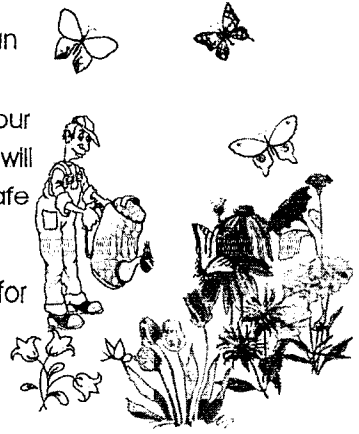
Public Notice

Need Help With Chores? Rent -A-Kid

The Rent-A-Kid program, sponsored by the York County Area Agency on Aging (YCAAA), is a unique, intergenerational program bringing senior citizens and teenagers together. York County senior citizens, 60 years of age or older, who need help with household chores, odd jobs, yard work, or snow removal are matched with a teenager in their area who can assist. The recommended payment is \$ 5.00 per hour, but is negotiable depending upon the job. Don't wait until the weeds are too long or the leaves need raked!
