## UNUSED MEDICINE

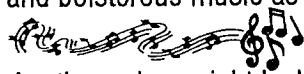


The unused medications in your medicine cabinet need disposed of, do you flush them down the toilet? This is a growing problem across the country. There is now a safe way to dispose of these medications. A new web site, [www.disposemy meds.org](http://www.disposemy meds.org), allows consumers to search for a participating pharmacy disposal program, by city, state or zip code. It is estimated that more than 4 billion prescriptions are written annually in the United States and up to 40% of drugs dispensed outside of hospitals aren't taken. This generates some 200 million pounds of unused pharmaceuticals each year. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has expressed concern of these medications finding their way into the environment. A safe and practical disposal program can make a real difference in protecting the environment. So before you "flush" that old prescription, check out the web site noted above, and help protect our environment.

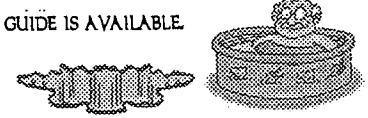

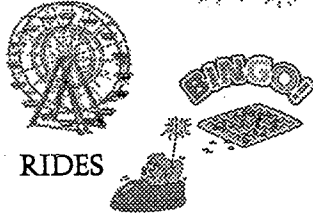
