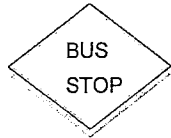

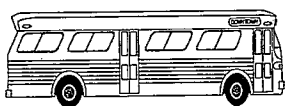

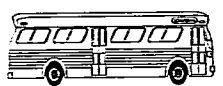


RABBITTRANSIT INFO.

Rabbittransit recently launched a new technology initiative known as **smarthop**, which offers state-of-the-art features to benefit its riders. One highlight includes the *Infopoint* section of the website, which displays real-time information giving riders the ability to view up-to-the-minute bus locations and departure times. An iPhone application is currently available and an Android app will be launched by Jan. 1, 2011. The smart phone applications can be downloaded for free by searching "Rabbittransit" in the App store. **Smarthop** also offers a rider alert system in which those who register for this free service through the website can receive service updates via email or text messages. 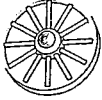

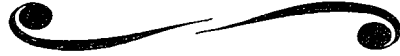

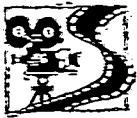
